



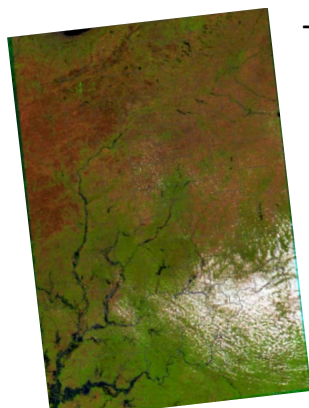
Indiana and YOU:

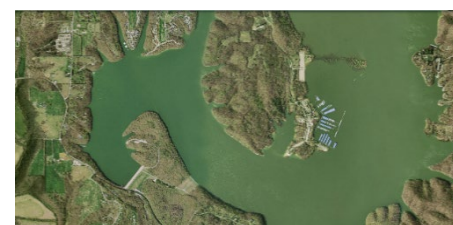


Each day has unique content featuring lessons, activities, resources, speakers, and fieldtrips integrating civics, geography, economics, and history focused on Indiana topics.
