Grant Goals

PCEE Mini-Grants are now available for 2017-18 to encourage effective and motivating curriculum projects that will promote economic education in K-12 classrooms. Funds can be used for many purposes, and creative projects are encouraged! Grant recipients for 2016-17 used funds to organize a career fair, buy materials to start a classroom business, and to purchase software for a life skills class. Funds may also be used to support teacher training or purchase curriculum materials.

Mini-grants are competitive and open to all accredited public and private K-12 schools in Northwest Indiana, including Howard and Marion counties. Grants will be for a maximum of \$800 per school. Multiple schools from the same corporation may apply. Up to three grants will be awarded.

Grant Timeline

- The official grant application and instructions are available on the PCEE website. Fully completed applications with signatures must be received by the PCEE on or before **Wednesday, October 11, 2017**.
- Grant proposals will be reviewed by staff members of the Purdue Center for Economic Education and the Indiana Council for Economic Education. Recipients will be announced by **November 1**. The target date for schools to receive funding is Tuesday, November 22, 2017.
- Funds must be spent during the 2017-18 school year.
- A final report from the project leader must be submitted by **July 30, 2018**. Unused funds over \$1.00 are to be returned to Purdue University.
