

The Paul Samuelson Award for Community Leaders



This distinguished award honors community leaders who have demonstrated outstanding commitment to economic education in their community. The award is given in honor of Paul Samuelson, a native of Gary, Indiana, who founded the Massachusetts Institute of Technology's graduate department of economics. Dr. Samuelson was the first American to receive the Nobel Prize in Economics.

The specific judging criteria are:

- Personal involvement with economic education programs
- Leadership in obtaining commitments to economic education from the public and/or private sector.

Eligibility

- A community leader from the public or private sectors, nominated by an Indiana Council for Economic Education (ICEE) regional Center for Economic Education director.

Award

- Recipient will be honored at the annual fall Awards Program for Economic Excellence of the Indiana Council for Economic Education.

Judging Criteria

- **Personal involvement** with economic education programs. (Identify specific ways nominee has been involved personally with programs in economic education.)
- **Leadership** in obtaining commitments **from the private sector**. (Identify ways in which nominee has obtained commitments from the private sector, e.g., soliciting program speakers, recruiting volunteers, involving parents or students in economic programs, or obtaining financial support.)
- **Leadership** in obtaining commitments **from the public sector**. (Identify ways in which nominee has promoted programs for teachers, curriculum development projects, **Economics**America school programs, and any role in establishing partnerships between ICEE and the Center for Economic Education and other state agencies.)

Nominating procedure

- Use the Nomination form provided on the reverse side. (Please type or print)
- Use a separate form for each nomination.
- Support material is recommended, including letters of reference and/or other print material relating directly to the nomination.
- Nominations must be received **in** the ICEE office before June 15.
